FIELD TRIP TO PUMPKIN PATCH:

Tuesday Oct 22nd we will be visiting Hee Haws with all their fun Fall & Halloween activities. This is always such a popular field trip, many parents choose to attend with their child but that is NOT required. Please note that this trip is free for students and chaperones, but will cost \$3.50 per person if bringing siblings or parents not assigned to chaperone. If you would like to chaperone a small group (usually around 3 children) please notify us by email ASAP. This year we will be taking a large van as a school so, while we still need chaperones, you will not necessarily have to drive children yourself and/or have adequate space in your vehicle. YOU MUST NOTIFY US BY OCT 14th IF YOU WANT US TO TRANSPORT YOUR CHILD TO THE FIELD TRIP; otherwise we will assume you are taking your child yourself. Field trip will be during normal AM class hours (9:30-11:30) for those whom we are transporting; parents driving their own children can meet us at Hee Haws at 9:45 AM but we MUST ALL ENTER AS A GROUP. All classes will be combined on the field trip-THERE WILL BE NO AFTERNOON CLASSES ON THE DAY OF THE FIELD TRIP, NOR on the following Wednesday Sept 23rd, as the field trip takes the place of those classes. Please watch your email for further details as we get nearer to these dates.
